In the second hour, children will engage in physical activities that promote motor skills and coordination while learning Italian words and expressions related to movement, body parts and sport in general.

In the third hour, children will immerse themselves in Italian literature, listening to famous fables read by our teacher. This is the best way to get them used to understanding the language while practicing their comprehension skills and learning new stories at the same time.
